Minimum Qualifications for Oakton Community College Faculty (Full and Part-time)

These minimum qualifications stipulate the required criteria a faculty member, full-time or part-time, must meet in order to teach in an Oakton Community College credit program, including remedial courses offered through regular Oakton departments (excluding the Alliance for Lifetime Learning). They comply with Illinois state requirements and conform to generally recognized professional standards within the disciplines.

Statement of Principles

- 1. These criteria are established as minimums. They do not necessarily reflect current faculty qualifications, ideal or desired qualifications.**
- 2. Some departments may establish higher standards in response to the requirements of external accrediting agencies.**
- 3. The minimum criteria shall be the same for both full-time and part-time faculty members.**
- 4. All faculty members employed to teach vocational courses shall have a minimum of 2000 work hours in the field. In addition, the normal expectation for faculty members teaching vocational courses is that they hold an earned baccalaureate degree, except in those fields in which the work experience and related training is the principal learning medium.**
- 5. All faculty members employed to teach transfer courses shall hold an earned Master's degree, with a minimum of 18 graduate hours in the discipline they teach. In those disciplines wherein there are other generally accepted standards and practices, upon the recommendation of the Dean and the approval of the Vice President for Academic Affairs, exceptions may be made.**

Departments may establish preferred standards for the department and preferred standards for teaching specific courses. Such preferred standards serve as guides for hiring.
